Metrc – Implementation Timeline

We are excited to announce the official implementation timeline for licensed cannabis businesses transitioning from BioTrack to Metrc as Illinois' track-and-trace data system. The implementation will start with transporter licenses and registered testing laboratories, followed by cultivation centers, craft growers, and infusers, and with dispensaries transitioning last. The phased approach ensures a smooth and efficient migration across the supply chain and minimal disruption to cannabis medical patients and consumers.

The important upcoming dates are:

- Phase 1: April 1-18: Transporters and Testing Laboratories
 - Gain access to Metrc,
 - Prepare staff and (for labs) Lab Information Management systems,
 - Review processes and procedures,
 - Ready for transporting or testing items from other licensees in Metrc.

• Phase 2: April 25-May 25: Cultivation Centers, Craft Growers, and Infusers

- Gain access to Metrc,
- Prepare staff and inventory management systems,
- Review processes and procedures,
- Transition and tag inventory into Metrc system.
- *Phase 3:* April 25-June 17: Dispensaries
 - Gain access to Metrc,
 - Prepare staff and point of sale / inventory systems,
 - Review processes and procedures,
 - Receive Metrc deliveries and packages,
 - Transition and tag inventory into Metrc system.

By the end of Phase 2 and Phase 3, those licensees should have inventory tagged and recorded in Metrc. For production facilities (*Phase 2*), that means starting new plants in Metrc early will minimize the need for moving intermediary or final products from BioTrack to Metrc. For dispensaries (*Phase 3*), that means reducing excess inventory with BioTrack tracking barcodes will minimize retagging of products before June 17. Metrc has additional information and support available online (https://www.metrc.com/partner/illinois/).

To move items into Metrc, plants and packages will need Metrc RFID Tags. Additional information will be available soon about the ordering process for those Tags. Through State funding, cannabis business establishments will not be charged for Metrc's RFID tags, subject to certain restrictions.

Important details:

- All cannabis plants will be tagged or re-tagged in Metrc.
- BioTrack packages with test results should be moved through the supply chain and sold.
- Unprocessed packages without test results will be re-tagged and converted to Metrc.
- Dispensaries will be given time to sell through as much BioTrack-tracked inventory as possible before the full transition to Metrc.
- Eventually, all BioTrack-tracked inventory will be re-tagged in Metrc.

Further dates, deadlines, and trainings:

- March 26, noon: State of Illinois cannabis businesses e-Townhall (register <u>here</u>, *to be repeated at March 28 presentation*).
- March 27, 9am: Metrc webinar for Testing Labs.
- March 28, 9am: Metrc webinar for Transporters.
- March 28, noon: State of Illinois cannabis businesses e-Townhall (register here, repeating March 26 presentation).
- April 7: Metrc webinar for Third-Party Integrators.
 - For cannabis businesses' IT vendors to ask questions and hear about the technical integration steps.
- April 21-24: Metrc Roadshows for all cannabis businesses.
 - All licensees can meet, take training, and ask Metrc questions about the transition process.
 - In person in Chicago, Springfield, and Mt. Vernon or Carbondale (*locations/times to be announced soon*).
- May 25: Testing Laboratories report lab test results in Metrc only.
- June 2: All product transfers in Metrc only.
- June 17: All cannabis licensees should be transitioned into Metrc.
- July 1: Metrc becomes the official cannabis inventory tracking system for Illinois.








Metrc implementation overview

The Metrc migration plan will follow a phased approach to onboard licensees in a timely fashion across the supply chain and to allow dispensaries time to sell through as much BioTrack tracked inventory before converting to Metrc.

You will receive an email from Metrc containing user credentials for the Metrc system.

Validate credentials by logging in.

Log into Metrc within 72 hours of receiving your welcome email and begin working in Metrc.




